

# Directions to Ogunquit

From:

Portland International Jetport – 45 miles

Boston Logan Airport – 70 miles

Sanford Airport (private aircraft) – 15 miles

Manchester (NH) Airport – 60 miles

Ground transportation or car rentals can be arranged from major airports.

210 miles from **ALBANY**

Route 90 South/East to Route 90 East (Mass Pike) to 290 East to 495 North to 95 North. Cross Piscataqua Bridge to Exit 7 – The Yorks/Ogunquit. Right off ramp; left at traffic light onto Route 1 North for 7.5 miles.

70 miles from **BOSTON**

Route 95 North. Cross Piscataqua Bridge to Exit 7 – The Yorks/Ogunquit. Right off ramp; left at traffic light onto Route 1 North for 7.5 miles.

175 miles from **HARTFORD**

Route 84 East to Route 90 East (Mass Pike) to 290 East to 495 North to 95 North. Cross Piscataqua Bridge to Exit 7 – The Yorks/Ogunquit. Right off ramp; left at traffic light onto Route 1 North for 7.5 miles.

60 miles from **MANCHESTER**

Route 93 to 101 East to 95 North. Cross Piscataqua Bridge to Exit 7 – The Yorks/Ogunquit. Right off ramp; left at traffic light onto Route 1 North for 7.5 miles.

314 miles from **MONTREAL**

Route 55 East (becomes 91 South) to 93 South to 101 East to 95 North. Cross Piscataqua Bridge to Exit 7 – The Yorks/Ogunquit. Right off ramp; left at traffic light onto Route 1 North for 7.5 miles.

45 from **PORTLAND**

Route 95 South to Exit 19 – Wells. Turn Left at the light onto Sanford Road. Follow to end. Turn right at light onto Route 1 South (Post Road) for 4 miles.

305 miles from **QUEBEC CITY**

QC73 to QC173 (becomes Route 201) to 95 South to Exit 19 - Wells. Turn Left at the light onto Sanford Road. Follow to end. Turn right at light onto Route 1 South (Post Road) for 4 miles.

290 miles from **NEW YORK CITY, NEW JERSEY AND SOUTH**

Route 95 North to 91 North to 84 East to 90 East (Mass Pike) to 290 East to 495 North to 95 North. Cross Piscataqua Bridge to Exit 7 – The Yorks/Ogunquit. Right off ramp; left at traffic light onto Route 1 North for 7.5 miles. (OR: Stay on 95 E and N to Maine.)
