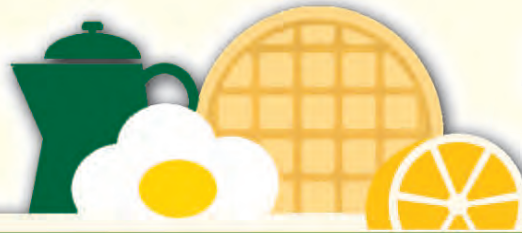

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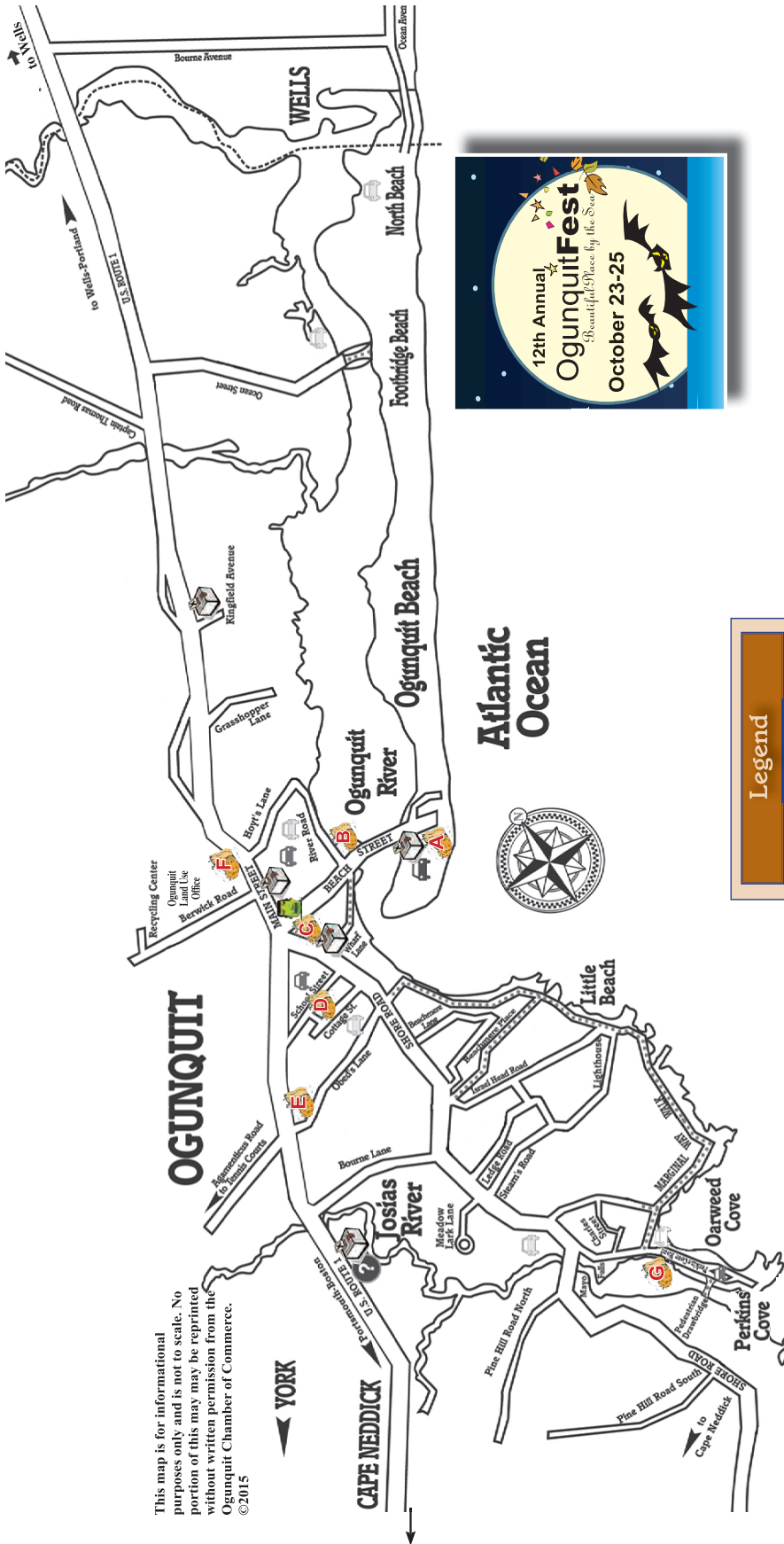

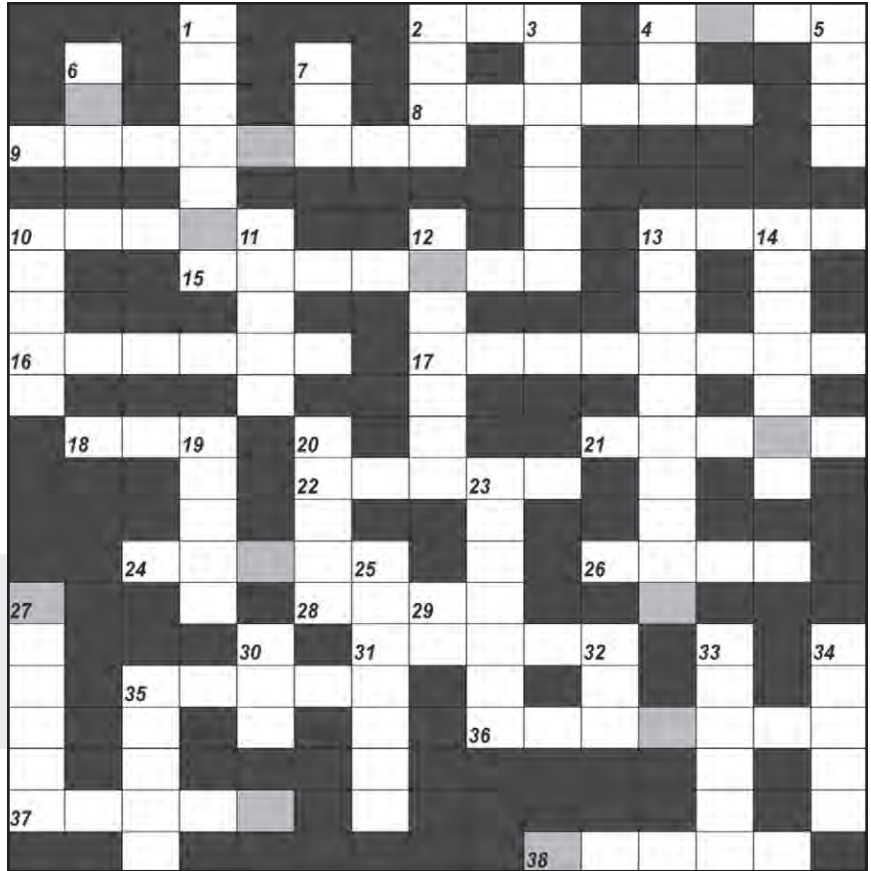

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Retail Store OgunquitFest Treasure Hunt

Please note, this will be easiest walking around in each location rather than driving.

X

First Word: (in Center of Town) Start at the shop at 1 Beach Street. The name has two words. The first letter of our phrase is the first letter of the first word. From there, look across Main Street to the high-end gift store. You want the fifth (next to last) letter in the name of that shop. Now turn down Shore Road, and find the shop with two of the same letter side by side in the first word. You need that letter.

Second Word: (in Perkins Cove) Find the shop across from the bathrooms that is between the toy store and the art gallery. The last three letters of the name of this store are the first three letters of our second word. The last two letters of the longer word are the next two letters you need.

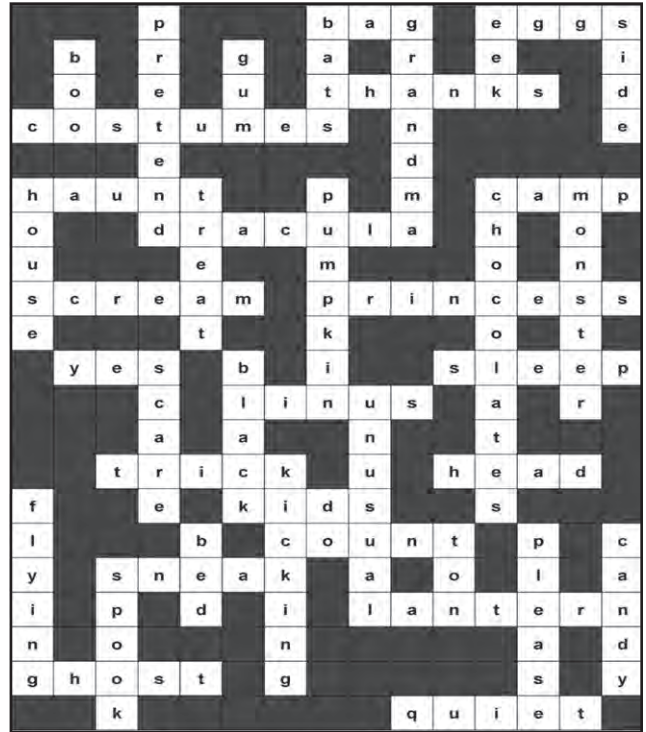
