Christian Parenting Threatened by California Bill

Family advocates are raising alarm over a new bill in the California legislature. It presents a "bill of rights" for the state's children. The proposed law assures children of the "right to social and emotional well-being," "right to parents...who act in their best interest," and "right to appropriate, quality education."

Also included is the "right to form healthy attachments...with adults responsible for their care and well-being."

This, of course, begs the question, by whose standards? California, along with over half of the other states, has already determined that spanking is not in the "best interest" of the child and outlawed it contrary to biblical standards.

Would home schooling still be considered an "appropriate, quality education?" Big

I have prayed, and now is the time. There is now a call to the reader of the tract to be saved, and the salvation page is in the back.

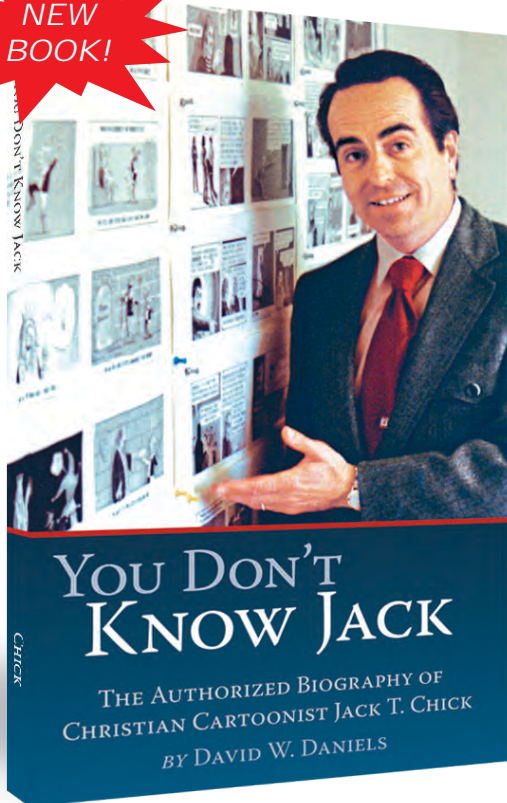

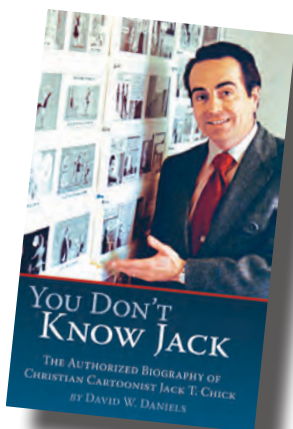

What's the Standard?

What do a ruler, a food scale and a Bible have in common?

Let's start with the ruler. It's a standard 12 inches (one foot) long. But, just like the name, it used to be measured by a man's foot. But whose foot? If we measure by my foot, mine might be bigger than yours. So if I'm buying stuff by my foot measure, I'll get a lot more. Or if I sell using my foot as the measure, you'll get a lot more. So no one would get in line to buy fabric from a person with small feet.

There has to be a common measurement.

Now look at a food scale. It is for measuring weight—in ounces or grams. In the Bible there was a weight called a "shekel." They measured out food (of course), silver, gold, brass (that's related to copper) and iron, in shekels.

Look at Exodus 30:13: "This they shall give, ...half a shekel after the shekel of the sanctuary: (a shekel is twenty gerahs:) ..."

"Shekel of the sanctuary" appears 25 times, in Exodus, Leviticus and Numbers. That means they had a standard. And it was God's standard that He showed Moses.

And look at Proverbs 20:23: "Divers [diverse] weights are an abomination unto the LORD; and a false balance is not

good." So let's think this one out. "Divers weights" are any weights that disagree, whether more or less.

God declared three things about diverse weights: 1) Not good; 2) An abomination to the Lord; 3) Thou shalt not have them. It doesn't get any clearer than that.

Follow with me here. We have a standard for weights. And we have a standard for measures. What about God's words?

Let's get real here. If we're talking English alone, we've got the American Standard, the Revised Standard, the New American Standard, the New American Standard 1995 Update, the English Standard, the New Revised Standard, the Holman Christian Standard and even the International Standard.

Here's the problem. They don't say the same things. So how can they be "the standard" anything?

Most modern Bibles have two things in common. First, they all say different things. That means they are "divers measures."

So, they are all like what? "abomination to the LORD."

Second, most modern Bibles agree (read their Introductions) that there was

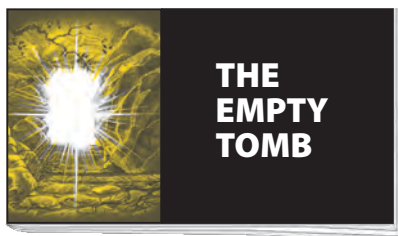

a standard, but it's now gone. That's the doctrine of Original Autographs Only. "OAO." The original writings written by men were (past tense) the scripture, but now, alas, they are gone.

Does God speak to that? Yes, Matthew 24:35; Mark 13:31; Luke 21:33 all agree: "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away."

But, if only the original autographs were (past tense) God's words, and alas, they are no more, then God's words (catch this) passed away!

Brother has already decided that teaching homosexuality to kindergarteners is “appropriate” in the government schools.

Would a belief in a Creator be considered poor “social well-being” when acceptance of evolution is the social norm?

Family watchdogs claim that the California bill is written so broadly that it would allow the state’s big government officials to decide abortion, sexual orientation and schooling options. They raised questions whether the state would have the authority to seize children from their families if conditions were considered contrary to the child’s “well-being.”

Of course, California’s push is part of a global effort to move control of our children to the state. The United Nations has a long history of meddling. Their latest effort is the Convention on the Rights of the Child, an effort to establish guidelines for assessing whether the circumstances surrounding the child is in his “best interests.”

Again, we have to ask, by whose definition? Often, that does not include consideration for biblical standards. With, for example, the global push to normalize same-sex marriage, would a parent’s objection to a school teaching this

“abomination” be considered not in the child’s best interest?

Several cases in Europe involved the state forcibly removing the children from a family simply because they wished to home school them.

The Sept/Oct 2013 BATTLE CRY (www.chick.com/bc/2013/scotland_law.asp) highlighted a plan in Scotland to have a government official assigned to every child to make sure that the child is well cared for —by the state standards. The plan has since been delayed because of public outcry.

On another front related to children, concern is rising over the nature of college educations. One source pointed out that the recent riots against the new president were largely carried out by young people educated in our universities. Placards they carried indicated a gross ignorance of America’s history, constitutional government and rule of law.

Christian leaders are cautioning parents about sending their children to these propaganda mills. Higher education can be more hazardous to young people than elementary and high schools. Secular

Does Your Bible Contain Legends?

—Some Do

Some skeptics today claim that the Bible is just a collection of legends in spite of ongoing archaeological and historical research. Only the willfully ignorant still claim that Jesus did not exist.

But for 30% of the Bibles published by the United Bible Societies (UBS), they may have a point. They do contain various “legends” known as the “Apocrypha,” aka: Deuterocanonical books.

It is fascinating how God guided the preservation of His words in the hands of the Hebrews over the millennia of the Old Testament. But even there, Satan had his counterfeit scriptures. Soon as the books of the New Testament were written, Paul’s “grievous wolves” were hard at work.

To discredit the Old Testament, Greek “scholars” working for the emerging prostitute church of Rev. 17 and 18, inserted these unbiblical “legends” into the Greek translations. Then, for over a thousand years, this counterfeit church still insists that these fairy tales are part of the Bible. In fact, it needs them because they have continued to practice a number of pagan rituals based on these legends.

Purgatory, for one, is based on the Apocryphal book, 2 Maccabees 12:43-46; indulgences and praying for the dead: (paying money to forgive sins) on Tobit 12:9.¹

The popes have claimed that these legends belong in the Bible because of one type of ancient Greek Old Testament called the Septuagint. Based on the fraudulent Letter of Aristeas, they claim that the Septuagint originated miraculously nearly 300 years before Christ.

Therefore, they reasoned that, since Greek was the common language of the Roman Empire, the Septuagint must have been the scriptures used by Jesus and the Apostles. Then if they used it, we should, too.

But the Septuagint contains the Apocrypha, the legends and fairy tales that none of the New Testament writers recognized as part of

the Hebrew Old Testament. But this did not stop the counterfeit Roman Catholic “church” from insisting over the centuries that it belongs in the Bible.

Now that the Jesuits have insinuated themselves into the Bible translation process, more and more modern translations are published containing these legends.

In fact, author David W. Daniels describes, in his book, [*Why They Changed the Bible*](#), how even Wycliffe Bible translators on the mission field are forced to include a translation of these legends in new Bibles upon request.

Daniels has used modern research techniques on the Internet to expose the hoax behind the use of the Septuagint. He shows that it is not old enough for Jesus to have used it. There is no evidence supporting Catholicism’s claim that it existed before the first century AD.

Therefore, their main argument that the legends of the Apocrypha belong in the Bible falls flat. Daniels’ new book, [*Did Jesus Use the Septuagint*](#), explains the details of this fraud. This book adds to the series by Daniels exposing the monstrous plot by Satan to destroy our faith in our Bibles. He shows how “doubting notes,” contradictory readings, and missing verses leave the reader of most of the modern Bibles with no way to be sure he really has what God wants us to know.

Satan is again whispering, “Yea, hath God said?” like he did in Eden’s garden.

Daniels assures us that, when someone claims that the Bible contains legends, we should help them understand that, while true of modern Bibles, one Bible stands free of doubting notes, missing verses and fairy tale legends. The history of the King James Version is reliable evidence that Jesus kept His word that heaven and earth would pass, put His words would always be available (Matt 24:35, Mark 13:31, and Luke 21:33.)

Missions Fund Report



INDIA — The Chick Missions Fund works with a number of organizations in India. One of those organizations is People’s Baptist Ministry to India (PBMI). Working on a very large scale across India, these brethren have won over 250,000 Indians to Jesus Christ, planting over 2,700 churches.

In 2016, the Chick Mission Fund provided 100,000 Chick tracts for PBMI’s big summer outreach. Their Bible school students, instead of going home for summer break, went to 29 of India’s 30 states to hand out tracts, conduct street and cottage meetings, and go door to door to reach their country with the Gospel. By year-end, they reported seeing over 17,000 Indians come to the Lord, and another 75 churches started.

HONDURAS — Missionary Daniel LaVita (Bible Baptist Missions) has received thousands of tracts. He writes,



“many here in La Ceiba know we have them and they come looking for us, we usually hear how much they liked them and now they want to give some to their relatives, even the backslidden. Worldly Christians



ask us if they can help to give them out. Other groups charge for their materials or have some kind of string attached so the people can be a little hesitant at times, but when we tell them they are free, they all seem relieved and give us a big smile.”

ETHIOPIA — Missionary Ray Hoover receives a steady supply of tracts through the Mission Fund. He travels around, visiting many small villages. He also supplies local believers who help him pass out tracts. He writes: “There is a young man from Uganda who came to our church a few months ago. He said that two of our evangelists had given him a tract and led him to Christ and now he had decided that he should come and be part of our church. For the last several weeks he has started discipleship classes with Bro. Teddy and is doing fine.”

FRANCE — Missionary Danny Flowers (Baptist International Missions) uses Chick tracts here. He writes: “I took them to the entry of a huge rock festival last week and they were very well received. Praying that the Lord uses them.

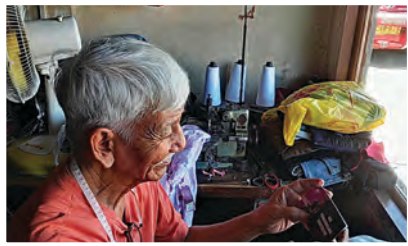

MEXICO — Missionary Mike Wallace writes: “They are so well accepted here in Mexico City and there is over 20 million people in the city and other 16 million



around the edge of the city. We have had some people approach us here saying they received Christ after receiving the tracts that we gave them —those that you sent. 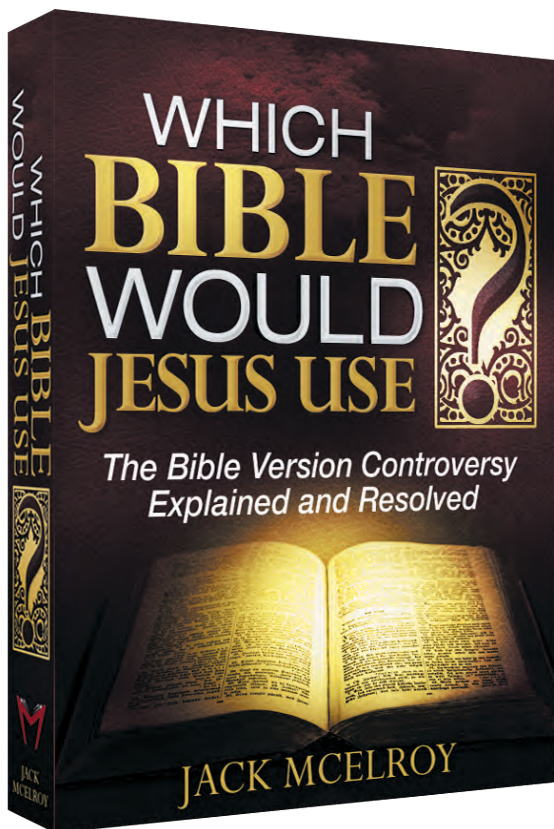

We have watched the fulfillment of Zechariah 12:3 with seemingly "...all the people of the earth gathered together against it."

The pope continues to be a major player

in the drama. He recently welcomed Palestinian President Abbas to the Vatican to inaugurate a Palestinian embassy to the Holy See. The pope took the occasion to stress "...the sacred nature of Jerusalem." Behind that statement is a long history of Vatican pressure to "internationally guarantee" the status of Jerusalem to "safeguard its sacred character."

That, of course, is the heart of the matter: by whose definition of "sacred?" Both Jews and Muslims claim exclusive "sacredness." Jews have a track record of honoring the devotion by permitting Christians to visit their sacred sites, allowing tourism and pilgrimages.

Even Muslims are generously allowed wide access to their Dome of the Rock. The rub comes when Islam declares that no one else can be allowed there once they come to power.

The world is getting tired of the hassle. Internationalizing the city would necessarily involve the United Nations where the Muslims have a powerful lobby and voting power. Here the pope is presuming a global power strong enough to defeat everyone else's demands. Sounds like the anti-Christ. Some have suggested that a pope will eventually be the anti-Christ's false prophet.

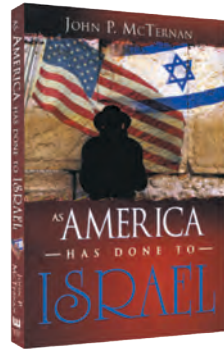
In the past, some have proposed, in exasperation, that the Jews should just give up and move to someplace like

We are instructed to "pray for the peace of Jerusalem" in Psalms 122:6. The rest of the verse is a promise: "They shall prosper that love thee."

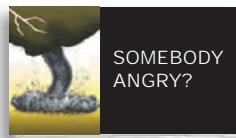
As long as Jerusalem is at peace, we are more likely to have freedom to get the gospel out. When war erupts, it may hinder our freedom to extend the Kingdom.

No! This is not the time to be silent, or murmur and complain, like Israel of old. Now is the time to get the Gospel everywhere we can spread it.

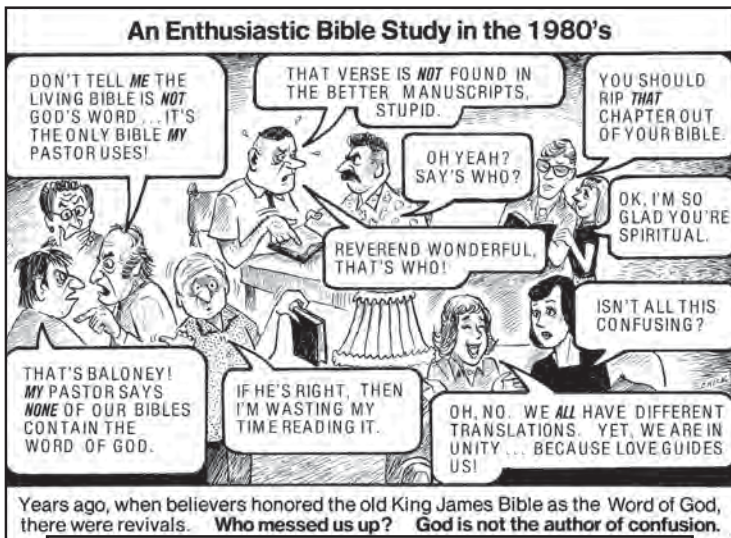
