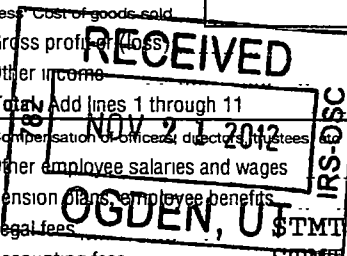

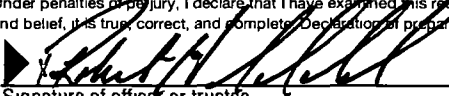

Inner City Christian Federation

The Dick and Betsy DeVos Family Foundation ("Foundation") has made no-interest bearing loans to the Inner City Christian Federation ("ICCF") to acquire property to assist with their urban renewal efforts.

Promissory notes totaling \$2,442,197 have been executed from 2006 through 2010. On June 2, 2011 the notes were consolidated, amended and restated into one note promissory note. The outstanding balance of the note as of December 31, 2011 was \$2,442,197.

ICCF provides housing opportunities and services that encourage family responsibility and independence, thereby helping to build stable communities. They have been

providing housing opportunities and services for low and moderate income families in the heart of Grand Rapids since 1974. The programs have expanded from housing construction and reconstruction to include an affordable rental program, an emergency family shelter, and an extensive home ownership preparation program. They have rehabilitated or constructed more than 530 units of housing and provided countless hours of housing counseling.

#### School of Missionary Aviation Technology

The Dick and Betsy DeVos Family Foundation ("Foundation") has made a no-interest loan to the School of Missionary Aviation Technology to repay existing debt and assist in its capital campaign.

A promissory note of \$400,000 was executed on March 1, 2009. The outstanding balance of the note as of December 31, 2011 was \$200,000.

The School of Missionary Aviation Technology equips men and women with the skills necessary to serve God in mission aviation. This is accomplished by providing performance based training in maintenance, flight, and related technical disciplines; and through hands-on experience in both laboratory and field environments. They are a private, non-affiliated school - who partner with and train students from a number of schools and mission agencies. They are one of only three mission aviation schools in the USA. They recently purchased a new hangar building at the Ionia county airport for their lab and flight departments.

#### Stockbridge Boiler Room

The Dick and Betsy DeVos Family Foundation ("Foundation") has made a no-interest loan to the Stockbridge Boiler Room to purchase a home that is used for its charitable purposes.

A promissory note of \$33,000 was executed on January 21, 2008 with a maturity date of January 31, 2011. Upon maturity, the balance of the note was forgiven. Therefore, the outstanding balance of the note as of December 31, 2011 was \$0.

The Stockbridge Boiler Room is a simple Christian community that keeps a rhythm of prayer, learning and celebration while serving the poor and the lost in the urban West Side of Grand Rapids. Their mission is to be true to Christ, to be kind to others and to bring the Gospel to the nations. They have recently established the Stockbridge Mission Church and are exploring the idea of opening a school in the neighborhood.

#### Urban Institute for Contemporary Arts

The Dick and Betsy DeVos Family Foundation ("Foundation") has made a no-interest loan to the Urban Institute for Contemporary Arts ("UICA") to assist with financing of capital improvements.

A promissory note of \$1,600,000 was executed on December 28, 2009 with a maturity date of March 31, 2011. Upon maturity, the balance of the note was forgiven. Therefore, the outstanding balance of the note as of December 31, 2011 was \$0.

UICA offers the community innovative experiences in the latest art forms and exposure to the newest creative ideas. They present programs in visual arts, film, dance, literature, performance art and music and provide artists with studio space, sales support and educational opportunities. They also provide a forum for inclusive community dialogue, challenges stereotypes, and promote arts and cultural awareness. In 2011 they moved into their new facility on the southwest corner of Fulton and Division which features gallery space, two theatres, a youth studio, ceramics studio, two lounges, two reading areas, an artist-in-residence studio, and an outdoor sculpture terrace.
