1952, following visits by Baptist missionaries in the 1940's. The reserve became Aboriginal freehold under the Aboriginal Land Rights Act (NT) 1976 and the community is now within the Yuendumu Aboriginal Land Trust area with day to day decisions and management of the community vested in the Yuendumu Community Council.
