## Say no to cashless welfare!

The Coalition government plans to roll out a new program that will force unemployed Australians to live off only \$60 cash per week.

This Healthy Welfare Card will restrict 80% of unemployment benefits (Newstart) to a visa-style debit card, which can be used at government-approved locations only.

Newstart is already a scandalous **\$190 per week** below the poverty line. Many unemployed workers can only survive on the measly payment by buying second-hand goods, or shopping at local markets. This card makes these thrifty techniques impossible!

The initial rollout of the Healthy Welfare Card will affect 10,000 unemployed Australians across three remote areas in Western Australia (Ceduna, Kununurra, and Wyndham).

The Coalition plans to expand this program across all rural areas, affecting more than 100,000 unemployed workers.
