#### **Production history**

These recordings were collected by environmentalist Richard Munro Baker between July and December 1983 at and around Borroloola in the Northern Territory. They document oral histories of the Yanyuwa people in the Yanyuwa language and Kriol. Interviewees include Tim Rakuwurlma, Annie Karrakayn, Dinny Nyliba, Isaac Walayungkuma, Johnson Babarramila, Judy Marrngawi and Nero Wangkarrawi Timothy.
