These recordings were collected between August and October 2003 by Claire Bowern during fieldwork at One Arm Point, WA. The field trip was funded by an AIATSIS grant and its purpose was to research histories and Bardi language and songs of West Kimberley. Interviewees and performers include Bessie Ejai, Nancy Isaac, Margaret Davey and Jimmy Ejai. The collection was deposited at the Australian Institute of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Studies on 24 April 2008.
