Production history

These recordings were collected by Gavan Breen between 27 August and 10 September 1968 in Dajarra, Urandangi and Calton Hills, QLD, and Tobermorey in the NT. The purpose of the recordings was to document languages spoken by various speakers in the western QLD region, including: Warluwarra, as spoken by Fred and George Age; Wangkamana and Wanggadyara, as spoken by Jack Hanson; Arrente, as spoken by Victor Lynch; Bularnu and Wakaya, as spoken by Didgeroo Jack; and Garrwa, as spoken by Johnson Charlie.
