Production history

These recordings were collected between 22 July and 13 August 1974 by linguist Gavan Breen during fieldwork at Boulia, Birdsville, Retreat Station, Augathella, Roma and Cunnamulla in Queensland and Bourke in New South Wales. The field trip was undertaken to document the languages of the Pitta Pitta, Maiawali, Wanggamanha, Ngamini, Yandruwantha, Yawarawarka, Margany, Gungabula, Kungkari and Wangkumara peoples. The interviewees who participated in these recordings include Norah Jacks, Ivy Nardoo, Maudie Naylon, Bob Naylon, May Clark, Mick Tatten, Benny Kerwin, Emily Jackson, Minnie Dodd, Baker Lucas, Waverly Grimshaw, George Harrison and Laura Dixon. The collection was deposited with AIAS (now AIATSIS) in October 1974.
