These recordings were collected by Howard Coate in 1965 during fieldwork in the Kimberleys in Western Australia. The purpose of the field trip was to study the Bunuba, Bardi, Winjarumi and Jawi languages. Speakers include Jimmy Bird, George Yarbu, Muju, Tigon and Left Hand Spider. The collection was deposited at AIATSIS on 28 November 2008.
