Production history

These recordings were collected by archaeologist Roger Cribb between 1985 and 2000 during fieldwork at Aurukun, the Archer River, the Love River, the Ward River, Baileys Creek, the Pine River, Shell Creek and Weipa on Cape York Peninsula, Queensland. The purpose of the field trips was, in part, to survey the shell mounds and plants of parts of Cape York. Also among these recordings are discussions about permissions to enter Aboriginal lands, oral histories, Aboriginal stories in English and Wik Mungkan and Wik Ngathan, songs, and the identification of shells and plants in Aboriginal languages. Participants in these recordings include George Sydney Yunkaporta, Rex Walmbeng, Ray Wolmby, Billy Landis, Ina Hall, Joyce Hall and unidentified speakers and performers. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 16 January 2008.

ARCHIVIST'S NOTE

These recording arrived at AIATSIS in a very poor physical condition many of the cassettes had to be cleaned, baked and rehoused in order to salvage the information they contained. Once that was

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1	accomplished the audiocassettes were digitised to the AIATSIS archival standard. Upon assessment for inclusion into the AIATSIS Collections some were found to be irrelevant to the needs of AIATSIS and some were found to be blank. The field recording numbers given to the recordings are the numbers assigned by the audio technician while digitising them. The recordings therefore are not
	ordered chronologically as the information about dates, place etc. was largely gleaned from the recordings themselves.
