Production history

These recordings were collected between August and December 2003 by linguist and AIATSIS grantee Sarah Cutfield during fieldwork in the Weemol, Beswick, Bulman, Barunga and Katherine area in the Northern Territory of Australia. The purpose of the field trips was to create a record of traditional lifestyle practices such as making artefacts, collecting bush foods, fishing and preparing bush medicines. The collector also intended to document the Dalabon language during these activities. It was the intention that the recordings would be of interest to Dalabon people now and into the future, as well as to linguists and other researchers. Dalabon speakers include Maggie Tukumba, Margaret Katherine, Lily Bennett, George Jangawanga and Nikipini Dalak. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 25 January 2012.
