Production history

These recording were collected by linguist R. M. W. Dixon between 28 November 1971 and 13 January 1972 in northern New South Wales and north-east Queensland. They document various languages, including Gamilaraay, spoken by Tom Binge and Charlie White; Mbabaram, spoken by Albert Bennett; and Yidiny, spoken by Dick Moses, Richard Hyde, Pompey Langdon, Katie May and Tilly Fuller.
