Production history

These recordings were collected between 17 February and 5 December 1979 by Dr Brian Egloff, an AIAS grantee, during field work in Bega, Candelo, Kameruka, Wallaga Lake, Jerringa, and Nowra, NSW, and Wreck Bay, ACT. The purpose of the field work was to study the significance of Mumbulla Mountain to Indigenous people of the South Coast of NSW, as well as the history of Wreck Bay, and the lives, culture and beliefs of the people who have lived there. Interviewees include B. Smith, V. Heffernan, Ted Thomas, Reg McLeod, Bob Brown, Bill Campbell, George Brown, Norma Mould, Jane Ardler and Charlie Ardler. All the interviews are in English.
