Production history

These recordings were collected between June and November 1968 at Maningrida, NT by Annette Hamilton. They document songs, stories and oral history of people from Central Arnhem Land. Performers and interviewees include Doris Djindjingeroa, Topsy Yalpur, Margaret Gorabulabula, Mary Lalwatjal, Judy Andjurermunga, Barney Beibananga, Big Barney Gederuwanga, Barney Raritpala and unidentified speakers.

Annette Hamilton obtained a grant from the AIAS in 1968 to conduct research into the various aspects of women's live at Maningrida. These recordings may have been collected as a result of that grant.
