**Date:** 1979-1983

**Extent:** 55 sound tapes (ca. 60 min. each): analogue, mono + listing.

#### **Production history**

These recordings were collected between September 1979 and May 1983 in South Australia and western New South Wales. They document narratives, language and cultural discussions of the Paakantyi, Arabana, Wangkangurru, Adnyamathana, Wangkumara, Yarluyandi, Kuyani, Diyari, Arrente and Pertame peoples. Speakers include Sydney Stuart, Arthur Warren, Ben Murray, Elsie Jones, Gertie Johnson, Merna (Mona) Merrick, Frank Crombie, Linda Crombie, Tom, Kathleen McLean, Rosa Warren, Edie, Johnny Reese, Maudie Reese, Jack, Cecil, Bob, Ben and Sidney Smith. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 26 July 1984.
