Production history

These recordings were collected by composer Kevin James, with assistance from Sebastian Harris, between 29 June 2009 and 11 July 2009 in the Katherine region of Australia's Northern Territory. They feature short texts and conversations in Dalabon, Jawoyn, Kriol, Mayali and a small amount of English. Speakers include Phillip Ashley, Lily Bennett, Marie Brennan, Mildred Brennan, Queenie Brennan Bangûrn, Ivy Brumby, Derek Dalywaters, June Jolley, Margaret Katherine, Maggie Tukumba and Rosita Tukumba. The recordings were collected with a view to incorporating them into new musical works by James as part of his ongoing *Languages Project*, featuring various endangered languages from around the world. The Australian recordings were deposited at AIATSIS on 21 February 2011 by Sebastian Harris, a fellow composer based in Katherine, NT, who acted as James' linguist and guide.

ARCHIVIST'S NOTE

This finding aid was compiled from information provided by Sebastian Harris. Detailed item descriptions, featuring timing points, are not yet available as the collection has not been auditioned by AIATSIS staff.

The recordings were supplied as both WAV and DSDIFF files on DVD. The WAV files will be preserved, as the only way to play the DSDIFF files—apart from on the recorder which created them or within specialist SACD production software—is to convert them to another file type. The DVD carriers on which the DSDIFF files were deposited will be preserved however, and copies may be obtained on request until such time as the carrier or file format become obsolete.

The recordings in this collection (WAVs) have been arranged in the order they were created, not the order they appear on the DVDs (which was alphabetical; files IBMilB_090708_FamilyConversation_A to MTPA_090704_Weather were on DVD 1 and files MTPAJJ_090704_Bobo to QBMK_090711_Prayer were on DVD 2).

The titles enclosed in single quotation marks below were assigned by the depositor. File MilBIB_090708_SkinNames has the title 'A story about stories' but this has been left off the item list as it appears to be incorrect.
