Production history

These recordings were collected by Sandra Keen between 4 August and 19 September 1969 during fieldwork in Doomadgee and Mornington Island Qld. The purpose of the field trip was to document language, stories, songs, music and cultural discussions by various speakers in the Gulf region of Qld including Alice Gilbert, Sydney Webber, Dick Brookdale, Rosie Robertson, Biddy Shadforth (Shadford), Alice Marmies, Victor Walden, Lyndsay Roughsey, Larry Langley, Larry Gavenor and Don Robertson. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 15 October.
