Production history

These recordings were collected by educationalist and Bernard Van Leer Foundation Field Officer Julia Koppe between approximately 1969 and 1993 in Cherbourg, Queensland. The Van Leer Language Development Project created a language development program for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students in schools in Aboriginal communities in Queensland in partnership with the Queensland Department of Education and James Cook University. This collection includes a 1985 Cherbourg community meeting about education and the results of the Van Leer language program at that time, as well as various teaching and testing exercises with school children from years 1 – 3. Speakers include Julia Koppe, John Dwyer, Marian, Tracy, Casey, Ruby, Crystal, Jacky, Gordon, Colin, Matthew, and many unidentified participants (teachers and school children).

The collection was deposited on 27 August 2010.
