These recordings were collected during September and October 1971 by Margaret Lawrie during fieldwork at Dauan, Mer, Boigu and Masig in the Torres Strait, Queensland. The purpose of the field trip was to document songs and stories from these locations. The languages spoken and sung are Kalaw Lagaw Ya (Mabuiag dialect) and Meriam Mir. Performers and speakers include Elisala Bigi, Siwai, Robert Pitt, Moses Dau, Jacob Mathew, Edward Mosby, Ned Mosby, Lawrence Mosby and unidentified children.
