Production history

These recordings were collected between 4 May and 4 June 1976 by linguist Ian G. Malcolm and schoolteachers and teacher's aides during fieldwork at Carnarvon, Western Australia.

The purpose of the field trips was to document and analyse the English spoken by Aboriginal primary school students in remote communities.

Places where recording took place include: East Carnarvon Primary School, Ingada Village (Churches of Christ Mission), the Koorda Club, Carnarvon Reserve, Carnarvon Primary School.
