These recordings were collected by Michael Martin between 21 March 1968 and 30 January 1970 at Edward River, Queensland. They document songs, dance, language and stories of the Kuuk Thaayorre, Kunjen and Wik Mungkan people of north-west Cape York. Performers and interviewees include Benjamin Wartomen, Patrick Roger, Stingaree Barney Holroyd and Eddie Coleman.
