Production history

These recordings are dubbings of material collected by Janet Mathews between 1968 and 1969 in Brewarrina, Weilmoringle, Bourke and Sydney, NSW. The purpose of the original recording was to document songs, language, cultural discussions and oral histories with various Indigenous people in NSW. Speakers and performers include George Maranoa, Billy Reid, Ruby Shillingsworth, Jack O'Lantern, and Jimmie Barker. There is also a dubbing of a recording of Stephen Naminal and Eleanor Brooks from the NT playing the didjeridu and sticks.
