Production history

These recordings were collected between July 1986 and January 1987 by Anne Draper, Kabay Mau, Marina Babia, S. Ger, N. Tamwoy and Loretta Horn during fieldwork at Sandgate and West End in Brisbane and Mer, Saibai, Mabuiag, Moa, Badu, Poruma, and Waraber Island in the Torres Strait, Queensland. The purpose of the field field trip was to document the songs and hymns of Torres Strait Islanders. Song composers include Tat Thaiday, Sam Passi, George Passi, James Rice, G.
