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#### **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Clair Andersen was born in Tennant Creek, Northern Territory, and has family links with the Yanyuwa and Gungallida clans in the Gulf country. Her family moved to north-west Tasmania and Clair has been involved in many areas of Indigenous education, both in Tasmania and nationally, for over thirty years. Clair was an inaugural member of the Indigenous Higher Education Advisory Council (IHEAC), which ran from 2004-5 to 2012. The Council was an all Indigenous organisation set up by the Commonwealth Department of Education, Science and Training to provide policy advice to the Australian Government on higher education, research and research training issues in relation to Indigenous higher education students and staff.

Clair was also a member of the Australian Indigenous Training Advisory Council (AITAC) which was created in 2000 as an advisory committee to the Australian National Training Authority (ANTA) Board. It ran until the ANTA functions were transferred to the Department of Education, Science and Training on 1 July 2005. Clair attended the Full Council meetings and the

Indigenous Policy Sub-Committee Meetings. One of the main focuses of AITAC was Partners in a Learning Culture, Australia's national strategy for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples in vocational education and training.
