#### **Production history**

These recordings were collected between 25 March and 25 July 1996 by linguists Anna Ash, Norvin Richards, Ken Hale and Jane Simpson during fieldwork for Ngakulmungan Kangka Leman on Mornington Island in the Gulf of Carpenteria, Queensland. The purpose of the field trips was to research and document the Lardil language, its stories and songs. Interviewees and performers include Kenneth Jacobs (Kulthangarr), Lindsay Roughsey (Burrurr), Andrew Marmies, Ida Brookdale, Cyril Moon, Elsie Roughsey and Gladys Goodman. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 1 October 1996.
