### Production history

These recordings were collected between March 1986 and June 1986 by Noel Pearson during research for a History Honours thesis at Hope Vale on the Cape York Peninsula, Queensland. They explore the lives of people who were attached to the Hope Vale Lutheran Mission, particularly when under the charge of the missionary George Heinrich 'Muni' Schwarz. Some Guugu Yimidjirr language is included in these conversations. Interviewees include Nellie Woibo, Willie Woibo, Michael Charlie, Arthur McGreen, Anne Cameron, Bob Flinders, Peter Gibson, Fred Deeral, Syd McIvor, Glen Pearson and Tulo Gordon. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 12 August 2013.
