#### **Production history**

These recordings, featuring Warlpiri ceremonial singing, were collected by Rev. Laurie Reece between January and November 1969 at Warrabri, NT. The recording project was funded by a grant from the Australian Institute of Aboriginal Studies. Laurie Reece and his wife were Baptist missionaries at Warrabri (now Ali Curung) between 1960 and 1972. The performers on the recordings have not been identified.
