Production history

These recordings were collected between September and October 1974 by Dr Peter Sutton during fieldwork at Cooktown, Cape Melville, Clack Island, Cairns, Palm Island and Townsville in Queensland to research the culture and language of the Biyalgeyi people. Interviewees and performers include Johnny Flinders, Bob Flinders and Bill McGreen. Dr Sutton worked jointly with Athol Chase, Bob Layton, Michel Lorblanchet and David Harris. The collection was deposited at AIATSIS in November 1974.
