Support the locked-out textile workers

Since 1 December the Australian Dyeing Company has locked out its union workers because they insist on organising collectively as members of the Textile Clothing and Footwear Union of Australia.

The Company has:

- Offered to give workers a pay increase if they resign from the union and go on individual contracts
- · Threatened them with the sack
- Hired 45 Chubb security guards 24 hours a day to keep workers out
- Used non-union untrained students to do TCFUA members work
- Spent \$100,000 on security cameras and microphones to spy on protesting workers at the site
- Hired Peter Reith's personal lawyer to represent the company
