That is, if ten dollars in gold contains forty hours of necessary labor, that gold will es-change for for will buy as many pairs of shoes as forty hours of social labor will produce.

Generally speaking, a commodity containing ten hours of necessary labor will tend to ex-change for gold, or any other commodity con-taining ten heurs of necessary labor.

That is true when price and value are equal. But supply and demand cause commodities to exchange for self, above or below their value, temporarily.
