The whole family went along and not only gave their exhibition, but actually met Her Majesty and shook hands with her.

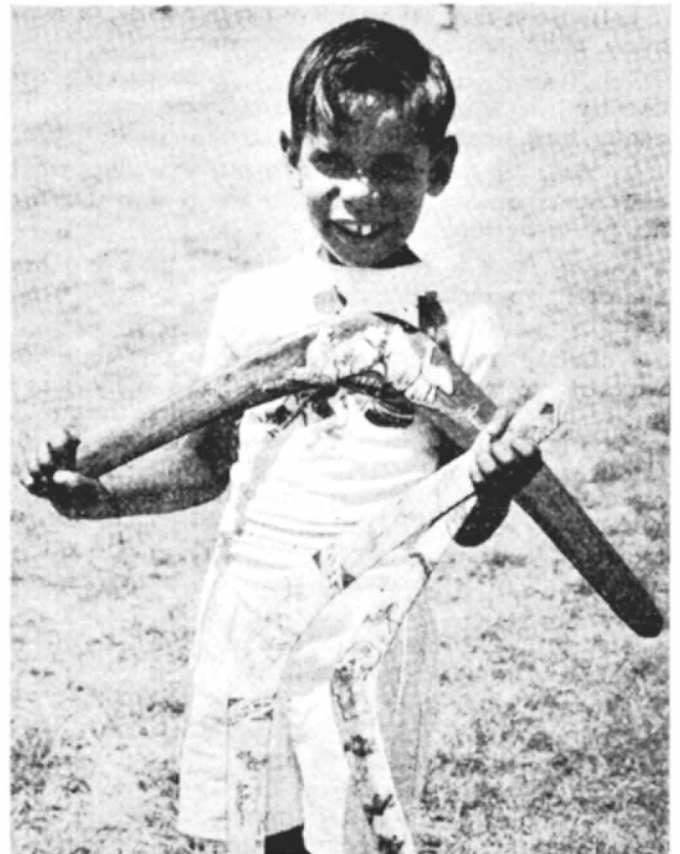
It is an experience they will never forget—the day they met their Queen.
