**Joseph Rotblat**, alumnus of the University of Liverpool, was a physicist who became known for his conscientious objection to the development of nuclear weapons and was a prominent critic of the use of science for military purposes.

This Legacies talk will feature a range of speakers exploring Rotblat's commitment to the use of science and technology for peaceful purposes – a commitment that won him the 1995 Nobel Peace Prize for his lifelong campaign against nuclear weapons – in the context of the University's relationship with the arms industry.

The session will be chaired by **Professor David Whyte**. Speakers include: **Greg Dropkin** (author of "Get Your Bombs Off Our Lawn"), **Riya Hassan** (Palestinian BDS National Committee) and **Professor Jonathan Rosenhead** (London School of Economics).
