Extent: 4 sound tape reels (ca. 60 min. each): analogue, mono. + field tape report sheets.

#### **Production history**

These recordings were collected between the 30 July and 31 August, 1973 by Gavan Breen during fieldwork in Charters Towers and Blair Athol, Queensland. The purpose of the field trips was to research Kok Nar, Gungabula and Bidyara languages. Saltwater Jack provided vocabulary for the Kok Nar language; Jimmy Lawton provided vocabulary for the Gungabula language and George Solomon provided vocabulary for the Bidyara language. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS in October 1973.
