Production history

These recordings were collected by linguist Colleen McQuay for the Diwurruwurru-jaru Aboriginal Corporation on 18 May and 27 November 2007 during fieldwork in Kathleen and Timber Creek in the Northern Territory. The purpose of the field trips was to collect narratives in the Ngaliwuru language. The collection also contains a reading of some Ngarinman sentences. Speakers include Doris Roberts, Clara Paddy and Noeline Nemit. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 8 October 2008.
