These recordings were collected by linguist R. M. W. Dixon between 12 and 15 December 1975 in Yarrabah and Ingham, in north-east Queensland, Australia. They feature a Yidiny text by Dick Moses, elicitation of Biyaygiri (a dialect of Wargamay) with Nora Boyd and elicitation of Nyawaygi with Willie Seaton.


