Production history

These recordings were collected by linguist Diana Eades in the Nambucca Heads and Purfleet areas of New South Wales between 1974 and 1976. They document the Gumbaynggir language, as spoken by Harry 'Tiger' Buchanan (Eades' principal consultant) and Ray McDonald.

The collection was deposited at AIATSIS on the 15 August 1977.

It could be Ray McDonald, who speaks on the next field tape, but it more likely Frank Archibald (whose name is mentioned twice in the narrative).
