Production history

This collection was recorded by Michael Edols as the sound component for the film *Here's my Hand: A Testimony to an Aboriginal Memorial*, in 1988, the year of the Australian bicentenary. It was produced with SBS Television, for and behalf of the Ramingining Community.

The subject is the Aboriginal Memorial which was on display at the Rocks in Sydney, being two hundred bone burial poles carved and painted by Arnhem Land artists to honour the deceased. The film incorporates documentary footage and ethnographic footage juxtaposed against the Sydney fireworks of 26 January 1988, and a speech by Charles Perkins. It is narrated by David Gulpilil. The burial poles now have a permanent display in the entrance wing of the National Gallery of Australia, opened in 2010.

The film is available as part of the Aspects of a Life collection, released on DVD in 2011 by Ronin Films.
