#### **Production history**

These recordings were collected by John Gordon between 30 July 1968 and 18 September 1968 in Moree, Tamworth, Woodenbong, Cabbage Tree Island, Armidale, Bellwood, Corindi, Burnt Bridge, Brungle, Sydney and Lake Tabourie, NSW. They were collected as part of an AIAS grant to record and transcribe Aboriginal music. The recordings document songs, music, language and cultural discussions by various people in NSW, including Frank Archibald, Albert Dennison, David Spearim, Roy Cutmore, Peter Burke, Richard Donnelly, Fred Laurie, Jimmy Runner, Harry Buchanan, Patrick Callaghan, Harry Cook, Mrs F Munro, Lila Hill, Kenneth Gordon, Ethel Gordon, Elsie Williams and Bill Campbell.
