Production history

These recordings were collected between 12 November 2002 and May 2004 by Tony Griffiths of the Key Centre for Tropical Wildlife Management, Northern Territory University, during field work in Central Arnhem Land. The field trip was funded by an AIATSIS grant, and its purpose was to research the oral history of harvest and management of mangrove clams at Maningrida, Cadell, Barridjowgeng, Markolidjban, Yilan, Marlobora Creek, Jibenna, Kopanga, Top Camp, Nangak and Garmadi, NT. The oral histories were conducted in Gunwinggu, Burarra, Ndjebbana and English. Interviewees include Lena Gurunyah, Nancy Bonson, David Angaraidja, Stuart Ankin, Jimmy Olsen, Dean Cooper, Pat Gamananga, Bill Namanja, Ricky Ginin, Mary Cooper, Therese Fry, Sally Stewart, Tracy Cooper, Peggy Mason, Kate Miwulga, Joe Watson Jr, Jackie Manburra, Bonnie Buiangarra, Lily Roy, Vicky Brown and Mary Namalaka.
