Production history

These recordings were collected by Mervyn Johnson for the Gurang Land Council in October and November, 1991. Mr Johnson and his uncle—Gooreng Gooreng elder, Nyulang Johnson—speak to various Indigenous and non-Indigenous elders in Eidsvold, Bundaberg, Rockhampton, Miriam Vale and Mount Perry in south-east Queensland about Gooreng Gooreng language and history. Some Waka Waka vocabulary is also elicited. Speakers include Mervyn Johnson, Nyulang Johnson, Joe Collins, Kate Rowe, Ivy Booth, Arthur Jeffery, Jack Bates and Percy Smith. The project was funded by an AIATSIS grant and the resulting material was deposited at AIATSIS by Mudrooroo Narogin Nyoongah (also known as Colin Johnson) on 24 July 1992.
