Production history

These recordings were collected by Van Leer Foundation Field Officer Julia Koppe between 1968 and 1972 during fieldwork at Palm Island, Cooktown and Cherbourg, Queensland. Many of the recordings were made as research vehicles for the Van Leer Language Development Project which was establishing an approach to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander education with the Queensland Department of Education. The program was largely directed at Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander primary school children.
