Production history

These recordings were collected by Tom Koychen, a non-Indigenous man, who lived and worked in the Kimberley region of Western Australia and Alice Springs in the Northern Territory, in the 1960s and '70s. Mr Koychen developed a keen interest in Aboriginal culture during this time and taped and photographed numerous ceremonies, often at the request of his hosts. Unfortunately none of the photographs have survived. The sound recordings, deposited at AIATSIS by Mr Koychen in May 2007, feature men's ceremonies from Mowanjum Mission, Liveringa Station, and Margaret River Station in Western Australia, and Papunya in the Northern Territory.

RELATED MATERIAL

A written account of an initiation ceremony recorded by Mr Koychen at Myroodah Station is held in the AIATSIS Library. Towards the end of the account there is brief mention of another ceremony at Liveringa, which may be the ceremony recorded on the second half of field tape 3.
