#### **Production history**

These recordings were collected between 21 April 1971 and 2 May 1971 by Janet Mathews while on fieldwork at Quambone, Lightning Ridge, Bourke, Brewarrina, Walgett and Coonamble, NSW. The purpose of the field trips was to research the languages, stories, customs and songs of the Wailwan, Yuwaalaraay, Muruwari, Wangkumara, Gamilaraay and Bidjara peoples. Interviewees and performers include David Brown (Wailwan), Mrs Welsh (Wailwan), Fred Reece (Yuwaalaraay), Ernie Sands (Yuwaalaraay), Jimmie Barker (Muruwari), Lorna Dixon (Wangkumara), George Harrison (Wangkumara), Charlie Dodd (Gamilaraay, Bidjara and Yuwaalaraay) and Bill Davis (Wailwan). The collection was deposited with AIAS (now AIATSIS) on 25 May 1987.
