BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

'Professor Janice Reid, FASSA, AICD, AM, has been Vice-Chancellor President of the University of Western Sydney since April 1998. She is a recipient of several awards and honours both in Australia and overseas, and has been a member of the boards of public agencies at State and Federal levels in the health, welfare, schools, higher education, energy, international relations and cultural fields. She has served on the Higher Education Council, committees of the National Health and Medical Research Council, the Academy of the Social Sciences in Australia, the Queensland Museum, Queensland Institute of Medical Research (QIMR) and as Chair of the Australian Institute of Health and Welfare from 1995 to 2001. She is currently on the Board of Integral Energy and the Commonwealth's Council for Australia Latin America Relations.

In 1994 she chaired the national review of nursing education in Australia. Her own research has been as a medical anthropologist in the field of indigenous and refugee health and health care, occupational and mental health. Professor Reid was made a Member of the Order of Australia in January 1998 for services to cross-cultural public health research and the development of health services to socio-economically disadvantaged groups in the community.'

Series 3 Yirrkala K.A.P study, 1975

The **K**nowledge, **A**ttitudes and **P**ractices (K.A.P.) of women survey is an instrument used to determine family health and planning.

This series contains 'Yirrkala K.A.P. preliminary report', by Janice Reid. It is based on data collected in January and February 1975 as part of a research programme in medical anthropology conducted with the approval of the Town Council.

The research was funded by grants from the National Health and Medical Research Council (principal investigator Professor J.E. Cawte) and the United States National Science Foundation. Copies of the report are also held by the Library at PMS 2324 and PMS 4359.

There are also completed, handwritten data sheets and a set of comments.

Series 12 Cyclone Tracy, Darwin, 1974

This series consists of newspaper clippings on Tropical Cyclone Tracy which hit Darwin in the early hours of Christmas Day 1974 (held at PC6/1). It caused extensive damage and led to the evacuation of most people from the town. There is also a booklet on the cyclone in Series 7, Folder 5.

Series 13 File of field notes and related papers, 1974-1983

The series is an additional deposit received in May 2006, mainly consisting of typescript and manuscript notes on 8" x 5" slips of paper of recording observations, events, interviews and other data gathered at Yirrkala and in its outstations and with Yolngu people visiting Sydney. The notes were probably used by Janice Reid as a working file to assist with writing her thesis and other publications. The arrangement of the original material has been disturbed as little as possible. The slips are in their original order in a file box (Box 7), divided in parts as listed below. Most A4 documents have been removed, unfolded and stored in Box 8.
