Production history

These recordings were collected between 10 May 1975 and 5 February 1988 by musicologist Douglas Myers during fieldwork at Beswick, Wadeye / Port Keats, Snake Bay, Bamyili, Garden Point, Urapunga and Springvale Homestead in the Northern Territory of Australia. The purpose of the field trips was to document the music of the peoples of Arnhem Land, Wadeye and the Tiwi Islands. Performers and speakers include Djoli Laiwanga, Hickey Hood, Long Lin, Long Stephen, Lofty (Bardayal Nadjamerrek?), George (Jangawanga?), Willy, Billy, Dick, Paddy Henry, Ian Viner, David (Blanasi?), Pius, Johnny, Ambrose, Butcher, Billy Naga, Thomas Woody, Tony and many unidentified participants. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 19 May 2016.
