Production history

These recordings were collected between May 1962 and May, 1976 by Marjorie Oakes, for the purpose of researching the Bundjalung language. Interviewees included Lyle Roberts, James (Jim) Morgan, Marie Roberts, Cecil Taylor, Steven Roberts, Cyril Roberts, Kinchela Davis, Dot Webb, Dick Donnelly, Marjorie Oakes and Frank McQuilty, who provide vocabulary, narratives and songs in Bundjalung and English. Mr Wilson and Mr Plough provide an oral history of the Kyogle area. This collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 18 October 1989.
