## Production history

These recordings of Groote Eylandt Mortuary ceremony songs for Narritjin Maymuru's son were collected by Dundiwuy Wanambi on the 30 January 1976 at Yirrkala, East Arnhem Land in the Northern Territory. The ceremonies are performed by members of the Wanungudjarrakpi, Wanungunga Tharrpilangu/Manganyurra clans of the Anindilyakwa people. They sing Guya (Yambirrku [mature] and Nukugudangi [immature]), Battjurr/Djurrpun (Evening Star) and Barra (West Wind). While they are singing, the Manganyurra clan take over singing of the Yambirrku. Members of the Wanungumathathi and Yirrkaku/Wurrakaku clans sing the Bilitjbilitj. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on the 9 February 1976.
