WHAT ARE THE MAIN ISSUES

Chinese enterprises have gained increasing prominence both domestically and internationally. However, the sustainable development of Chinese enterprises is still in the initial stage, and the following challenges still remain:

- In order to ensure companies' successful operation and to maximize their future prospects, Chinese companies must be aware and confront with potential risks in social, environmental, stakeholder engagement and other aspects. The sustainable development capacity of Chinese companies still needs to be strengthened with sufficient knowledge, experience and human resources
- Policies and guidelines to facilitate Chinese companies' sustainable development are in place, however, these have to be continued, unified, fully integrated, and better enforced
- Communication between Chinese companies and the stakeholders in the wider community shall be strengthened not only to respond to improve transparency, efficiency, and effectiveness

POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS

With the goal to minimize social and environmental risks and potential disputes during companies' domestic and overseas operation, whilst enhancing private sectors participation to achieve the sustainable development goals, we aim to implement and mainstream sustainable development values and practices at all levels.

For Companies:

- Raising awareness and consciousness of sustainable and responsible development, helping companies integrate sustainable practices into their business strategy
- Building companies' capacity to implement sustainable practices, enhancing companies transparency
- Facilitating communication between companies and other stakeholders such as local community, NGOs, government
- Documenting and sharing good practices of Chinese companies' sustainable development

For Government:

- Providing policy recommendations to better regulate and facilitate the sustainable development of Chinese companies
- Offering a case bank with best practices of the sustainable development of Chinese enterprises

For other stakeholders:

- Facilitating communication with companies to avoid misunderstanding
- Improving information sharing between companies and stakeholders



As the first cooperation between Chinese governmental research institutes and UN organization on this topic, the 2015 Report on the Sustainable Development of Chinese Enterprises Overseas systematically summarizes Chinese government's efforts on promoting sustainable development abroad, presents Chinese companies' overseas sustainable development practices in terms of corporate governance, economic, social and environmental perspective.

The report was launched in Beijing in November 2015, and was later presented in Johannesburg, in Paris at OECD, and in New York at UN headquarter.

主要问题

在本土和国际领域,中国企业已获得了越来越重要的地位。但是,中国企业的可持续发展仍然处在较为原始的阶段;于此,企业面临的主要问题是:

- 为确保成功运营并最大化前景,中国企业必须 注意到社会、环境、相关利益方和其他方面会 出现的潜在风险。中国企业仍然需要通过充足 的知识、经验和人力资源来强化其可持续发展 能力。
- 虽然用以促进中国企业可持续发展的政策和指导方针都相继出台,这些政策和指导方针都需要得到持续的执行和统一,最终达到完全整合和更好的实施
- 为了提高效率、效用以及透明度,中国企业和 利益相关方应当在更广阔的社区范围内进行对 话和交流。

可行措施

为了在企业的本土和海外运营中最小化社会风险、 环境风险和潜在争议,同时强化私营部门在实现可 持续发展目标的参与程度,我们计划在所有层面上 实施践行可持续发展价值。


